

## Necessary tools and materials:


Printer  
Paper A4- 3 sheets



Sewing machine  
Recommended threads No. 30  
(Or other thickness suitable for your sewing machine)




Scissors or STANLEY blade



Leather hole puncher



Buckles 25mm- 1  
Rivets 8mm- 10  
Lobster Claw Clasp-2



Leather, recommended thickness 0.8-1,2mm (can be used other materials like vinyl, mohair or others)

108 x 4cm / 42.5" x 1.57" - 2pieces  
41 x 4cm / 16.14" x 1.57" - 2 pieces  
25 x 6cm / 9.84" x 2.36" -2 pieces  
10 x 2cm / 3.93" x 0.78" - 1 piece



Total approx 0.16sq.m (1.672 sq.ft)

Little bit of leather adhesive and  
Masking or other tape.

## Printing the pattern

Set up your printer to A4 size paper and mark “Actual size” box.

Alternatively you can use “letter” format which is approximately the same size and will not impact the size of the pattern.

Print **Test** page first before printing all the patterns.
